Primary Laws which Regulate Payment of Wages and Fringe Benefits in Michigan

- Federal Law: Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938
 ("FLSA")
 - Michigan Law: Minimum Wage Act of 1964
 ("MMWA")
- Michigan Law: Wages and Fringe Benefits Act ("MWFBA")



Minimum Wage Regulations

All employees <u>must</u> be paid the minimum wage set by federal law.

The current minimum wage is \$7.40 per hour.



Overtime Compensation



EXEMPTIONS

The FLSA provides an exemption from both minimum wage and overtime rules for "any employee employed in a bona fide executive, administrative, or professional capacity . . . or in the capacity of an outside salesman."
