

Southfield lawyer awarded Lifetime Achievement Award



Robert D. Kaplow— a shareholder at Southfield law firm, Maddin, Hauser, Roth & Heller, P.C.— was honored with the Leonard N. Simons Lifetime Achievement Award by the Jewish Historical Society of Michigan, (JHSM). He is one of only four people to receive the award in the history of the organization.
